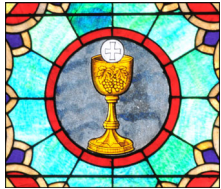
LECTIO DIVINA

Pilgrims will also need transportation once from Sacred Heart of Mary or Sacred Heart of Mary to their host homes and back again the morning of the 21st. Men and women lay persons can stay under one roof provided they room separately. Clergy may only stay with clergy. You are welcome to house a minimum of two and a maximum of 15. 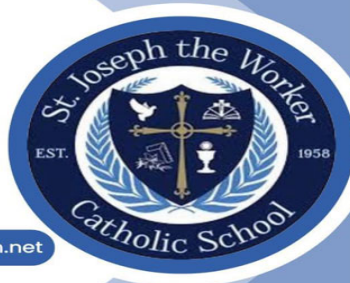
