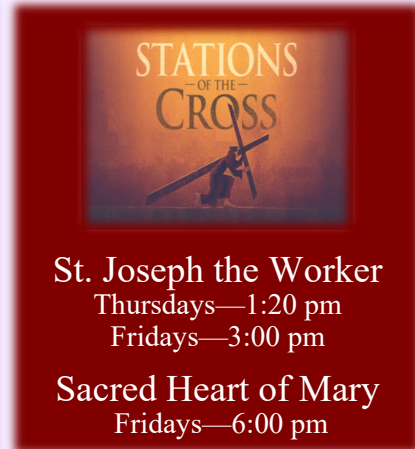
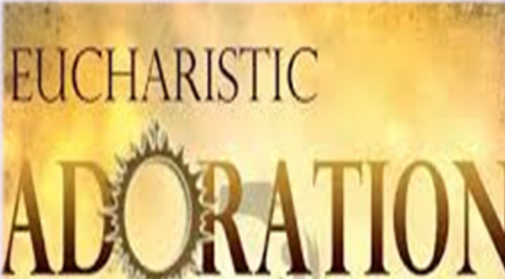

### THREE MAGIC WORDS



Flash back for a moment to your childhood. Raise your hand if your parents, especially your mama, tried to teach you manners as you were growing up. Were you ever told about the three "magic" words, that if used at the proper time, went a long way for you to achieve peace and happiness.

Did your parents ever say to you, "What's the magic word?" Three simple words that you very seldom hear anymore, for we live in a me, me, me world. Manners and respect for authority were always the "hallmark" of a good upbringing, but sadly they seem to be lacking in our society today.
