ARISE! BE A FAITHFUL COMPANION TO JESUS



If we truly believe, as the Church teaches, that Jesus is present Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Blessed Sacrament, then where the risen Jesus is, there also is Heaven, and with Him are the angels, saints and Mary. The very same Jesus that is at Mass is also present in the Monstrance in our Adoration Chapel. Because of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, Adoration is the natural extension of the Mass and therefore can be thought of as "Heaven on earth."

"After she died, St. Teresa of Avila, a Doctor of the Church, appeared to one of the nuns and said: "There is no difference, as far as purity and love are concerned, between the blessed in Heaven and the faithful on earth, though we are perfectly happy and you are suffering. What the Divine Essence is to us in Heaven, the Blessed Sacrament should be to you on earth." Another Doctor of the Church, St. Alphonsus Liguori summed it up similarly, "Here, then, is our Heaven on earth – the Most Blessed Sacrament."

Visit Jesus in the Adoration Chapel and immerse yourself in the presence of Christ. Then, as St. John Paul II said, "We must allow the Holy Spirit to help us become intimate friends of Christ. And, like Mary, we must put aside any fear in order to take Christ into the world in whatever we do. Through us, Christ wants to go to many places in the world and to enter many hearts." (Lessons for Living - Loyola Press) It is in this way, we can bring a little bit of Heaven to all those who need refreshment.
